

2017 City Leaf Collection for Glasgow

Q. What is the vacuum leaf collection service?

A. City Work Crews collect leaves that have been raked to the curb.

Q. When will the service take place?

A. Service begins Monday, Nov.6th and will be completed by the end of the year.

Q. When will leaves be picked up on my street?

A. The city has been divided into 4 zones, and each zone has been assigned two weeks of leaf pickup. To see your street's pick up schedule, please view the map.

First Round

Zone 1	November 6 th - 9 th
Zone 2	November 13 th – 17 th
Zone 3	November 20 th – 22 nd
Zone 4	November 27 th – December 1 st

Second Round

Zone 1	December 4 th – 8 th
Zone 2	December 11 th – 15 th
Zone 3	December 18 th – 22 nd
Zone 4	December 27 th – 29 th

Q. What do I have to do to prepare?

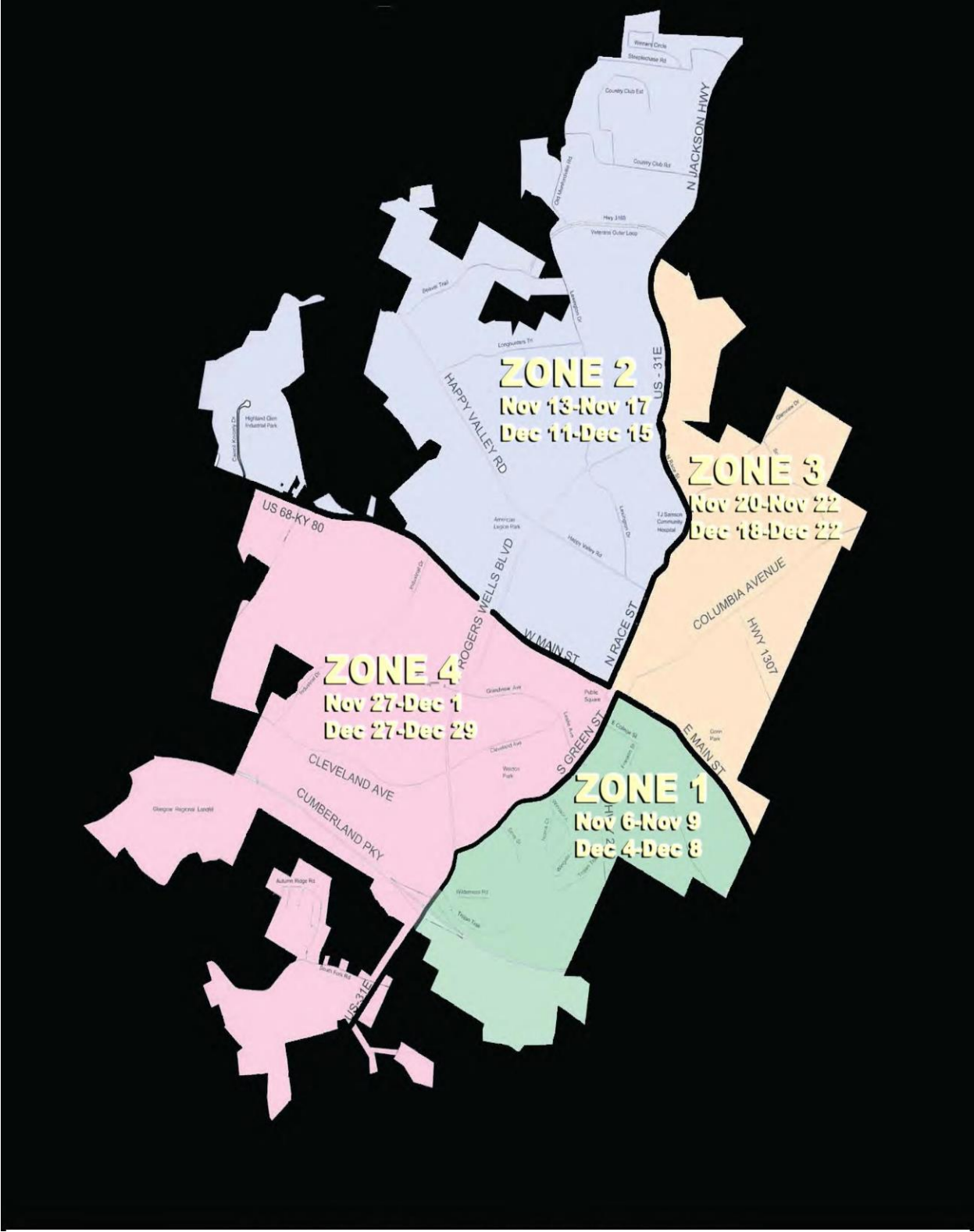
A. Residents need to put leaves in piles close to street or sidewalk before the start of collection week. Be mindful of safety. Do not put leaves in the street, on the sidewalk, or blocking drainage ditches. Collection is for leaves only. **Do not** rake objects that could injure crew members or damage equipment, such as **rocks or tree limbs** etc. into the piles.

Q. What if I really want my leaves removed before my scheduled collection week?

A. If you can't wait for work crews to reach your street, you may bag leaves and leave them by the curb for work crews to remove.

Q. What happens to the collected leaves?

A. Leaves are taken to the compost site at the landfill where compost may be purchased while supplies last.
