Job Placement Assistance. Career Counselors will discuss your Career Plan with you and assist you in discovering your skills and aptitudes needed to succeed in today's work place. There are many job openings and we hope to be able to assist you in obtaining a good, self-sufficient job in the Career Path of your choice.

The Internship Program is designed for those young adults (18 to 24) who desire to go straight into the workforce. The intern will apply at participating employers for positions related to an area for which the intern has an aptitude or interest. If the employer agrees to accept the intern's application, the intern will have a 250 hour internship earning the entry level wages of that employer for that position. The Intern can request any employer as long as that employer is willing to complete an Employer Application and agrees to accept the intern.

Tuition Assistance:

Eligible Young Adults (18 to 24) may apply for the tuition assistance program totaling up to \$4000 per year or \$8,000 over a 2 year period.

- Applied towards a 2 year Associate's Degree
- Certification Programs
- All programs must be on the State eligible provider list

Participants must receive credential within a 2 year period of enrolling and are required to apply for FAFSA.

- *Summer work experience may apply*
