To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:

Whereas, September 17, 2018, marks the two hundred and thirty-first anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its' memorable anniversary; and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

Whereas, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each by the President of the United States of America designating September 17th through September 23rd as Constitution Week;

Now, Therefore, We, the Public Officials of the City of Glasgow, County of Barren, in the State of Kentucky, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17th-23rd, 2018, as

“Constitution Week”

in Glasgow and Barren County. We ask all citizens to reaffirm the ideals of the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
