**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-2413**

**AN ORDINANCE DECREASING THE NUMERICAL COMPOSITION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL**

**THAT, WHEREAS,** the City of Glasgow operates under the mayor-council form of government, and the current numerical composition of its council is twelve (12); and

**WHEREAS,** Kentucky law – specifically KRS 83A.030 – provides that each city organized and governed under the mayor-council plan shall have a legislative body composed of not less than six (6) nor more than twelve (12) members and empowers the city’s legislative body to prescribe by ordinance the numerical composition of the council;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the City of Glasgow, Kentucky, as follows:

**SECTION ONE.** Effective January 1, 2021, when the new legislative term begins, the numerical composition of the city council shall be decreased from twelve (12) to nine (9) members; thus, in the November 2020 election, only nine (9) council members shall be elected.

**SECTION TWO.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
