PURPOSE

1. The purpose of emergency generators is to ensure that essential power services continue during power failure situations.
2. The emergency generators require careful maintenance to ensure reliability.

RESPONSIBILITY

1. It shall be the responsibility of each station officer or acting station officer to monitor proper preventative maintenance and testing of emergency generators.
2. The emergency generators shall be started (tested) on Monday for ten (10) minutes and the station officer or acting officer shall record the test and operation time in the daily logbook.
